

CMCA Traveller CarPlay Operation

Important notes

- CarPlay cannot be controlled directly from the iPhone.
- Trip Plans are not yet available on CarPlay and are still a work in progress.
- Some Traveller features are not currently available on CarPlay.
- The procedure below may vary slightly depending on the navigator type.
- Some vehicles with factory-fitted navigation systems may require the iPhone to be connected via cable to use CarPlay. Please ensure the cable supports file transfer.
- You may need to connect your iPhone to a power source, as CarPlay uses a significant amount of battery.
- CarPlay is not available on iPads.

Procedure

- Turn on Wi-Fi and Bluetooth on your iPhone.
- Connect the CarPlay navigator device to power and switch it on.
- Under Bluetooth, look for My navigator devices or Other navigator devices, then locate your navigator device (it will usually appear as a model number or code).
- Tap on your navigator device.
- Select Pair when prompted. A pairing number will appear.
- Select Allow when asked to allow Contacts and Favourites sync.
- Select Connect to connect to CarPlay.
- Confirm the pairing number shown on the CarPlay navigator device, then select Connect to CarPlay.
- Place the phone in the centre console or another suitable location where it can receive a GPS signal.
- On the CarPlay navigator device, locate the CMCA Traveller icon.
- Select the icon — Traveller is now active.
- Depending on the navigator type, select the Search icon on the screen.



- Explore will appear, displaying a menu of POI categories.
- Select a category.
- Use the search function or choose a POI from the category list.
- Select a Route if available.
- Select Navigate — turn-by-turn voice guidance will begin.
- To stop navigation, select the Stop icon (location may vary depending on the device).



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
